

Physician Instructions: Add New Patient

In order to use MyCancerJourney to help your patients, you must first register them with the system. You can then use MCJ's "MyInsights" tool to generate survival curves and print shared decision-making information which describes survivability with various treatment options. When a patient receives a new cancer diagnosis, start here. This simple document will walk you through the use of MyCancerJourney to assist you in best caring for that patient.

Step 1: Add the New Patient to MCJ

Log in to MyCancerJourney using your Physician's credentials.

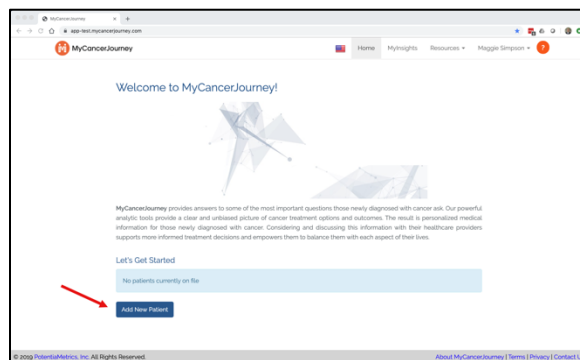

Step 2: Establish a Patient Identifier

Patients in MyCancerJourney are de-identified. You must use an external process to map from random patient identifiers stored in MCJ and your own records.

When adding a new patient to the system, you may use your own identifier or have MCJ generate one for you.

After establishing the patient's identifier, click:
